






Indications: Ideal for post-operative and post-injury immobilization of the knee.















## **Application Instructions:**

- Unfasten all straps and open the immobilizer completely.
- 2. Affix the foam to the inside of the immobilizer at the center of the brace.
- Position the leg over the affixed foam where the knee bends.
- 4. Adjust the outer detachable panels by removing them from the immobilizer and re-positioning them to obtain a more accurate fit to the leg anatomy. Affix them back to the immobilizer body.
- **5.** With the kneecap centered secure the first Velcro strap just below the knee.
- **6.** Secure the remainder of the straps in an alternating fashion until they are all completed.
- 7. A properly applied Tri-Panel Knee Immobilizer.

#### Use and Care:

Hand wash the immobilizer with mild soap and water and lay out to dry. Do NOT machine dry.
